

Healthy Communities Healthy Youth Meeting
September 19, 2009, 8:30am

Present: Marcie Mason, Dale Panovich, Caitlin Mocariski, Amy Snell, Suzanne Smaltz, Allison Schumacher, Colleen Campbell, Holly Karamis and Cathy Hochevar.

1. Secretary's Report from May 16, 2009 approved. Receipts for the decals were submitted to Copley Township, and we now have decals to give out in the community promoting HCHY.

2. Treasurer's Report: Dale reviewed the Treasurer's Report and reported \$1,627.29 in checking. Marcie reported \$110.00 will go to the Lauren Braman Scholarship Fund. Discussion on ideas for fundraisers so that we can have an income. Copley Township paid for the website for the entire year.

Colleen made a motion to spend \$50 to put an HCHY ad in the Copley HS student directory, seconded by Holly. Discussion. Motion passed.

Discussion on t-shirts and hoodies. We will see what orders come in.

Purchasing pens with our logo for \$200 for the Business Breakfast 11/12 and to give away as advertisement. We are also looking for corporate sponsors. Suzanne made a motion to order pens for giveaways, seconded by Dale. Discussion. Motion passed.

3. Allison reported that the Youth Committee had a meeting on 9/10. Everything went really well. Education Moment went smoothly, watched the video. Passed out forms for hoodies (due 10/24) and Haunted Halls permission forms. Respect program is 9/26, 8am-4pm at Children's Hospital; Allison will go. Pregame dinner on 10/30 will not be combined with Revere HCHY with a suggestion of beef and chicken taco dinner. Dale will look into cafeteria costs. Youth will participate in Copley Park Halloween on 10/31. Talked about making buttons with Mr. Tolle's picture as fundraiser. Youth will look into putting the funds toward a memorial dedication for Mr. Tolle. Youth Speak Out will be 2/20/10 to talk about issues for youth in school and community and will ask school personnel to attend. Halloween Haunted Halls meetings are 9/25, 10/9, 10/15. Set up will be after school on 10/23 and in the morning 10/24. Help is needed from adults and youth. Marcie asked for help from University of Akron students.

Dale made a motion to budget \$200.00 for Haunted Halls, seconded by Holly. Discussion that Marcie will keep track of the expenses. Motion passed.
