

HCHY Adult committee meeting, November 19, 2011

Secretary Report – No changes to October meeting minutes.

Financial Report - Haunted Halls brought in \$2,752.00 in admissions (500+ paying) and \$50 in donations from Copley Lions Club. There was \$919.28 in expenses leaving a profit of \$ 1832.72. Wow! Current balance in checking account is \$5565.28.

8-7-11 fundraisers - \$1869.00 taken in, expenses of \$635 were \$390 for wristbands and \$245 for t-shirts. \$37 of income was in checks that were already deposited in benevolent funds, leaving \$1160.00. The remaining money was deposited in benevolent funds set up for the families using a formula committee members felt was the most fair. Johnsons received $\frac{1}{2}$ (\$580), Dieters received $\frac{3}{8}$ (\$435) and Shambaugh received $\frac{1}{8}$ (\$145). Wrist bands are still available at Designer League. The committee will be donating 5 wristbands and t-shirts to the Johnson family in Germany.

No youth committee representative was present. Youth committee officers decided there would not be a Haunted Halls after party.

There were 384 HH evaluations/surveys completed. Indications are that 59% of attendees were middle school students, 31% high school students, 5% from elementary schools, and 5% adults. We were especially pleased with the way Karrie Rocklin and Lexxi Kearns handled the auditorium this year; there were no complaints about confusion in the auditorium. Mentioned as being the best part...the little girl on the bike, outside, chain saw, clowns, fog, movies at the beginning, actors jumping out, 3D room, the tent and the balloons.

Progress is being made on the Copley yard signs. A design with promise was submitted by Janet Tektas from Banner Printing and Promotional Products (Janet is a Copley parent.) Plans are to get final approval from the committee and have the yard signs available before Christmas.

Patty and Marcie will be selling spirit badges at the Winter Sports Community Night on Monday.

Youth Speak Out was on the agenda but with no youth committee representation present, it is unclear if we should proceed with planning that event or not. Need to have youth committee's input. YSO is scheduled to take place February 25th.

Chili cook-off is March 24th.
