

HCHY Adult Committee Meeting

October 9, 2010

Secretary's Report: Minutes of September 18, 2010 were approved. Thanks to Colleen Ahern for the minutes.

Financial Report: Dale Panovich reported a balance of \$3,265.79 in the checking account.

Carnation sale: Carnation sale made \$50.00. Youth Committee was congratulated for taking on this project and working on their own. Emily reported that next year, orders will be taken and filled on the spot. Carnations were purchased and used as a way to ask for a date.

Youth Committee Report: Haunted Halls: There was discussion about handing out coupons for Haunted Halls at the football games, and it was pointed out that they want this to be a Copley-Fairlawn community event. Nate reported they met with Ed Simpson and they can use the gates to cut the hallways off, not chairs. They have the radios and earpieces. There are now over 50 students helping. Officer Webb reported about three officers will be assisting, and it was discussed where the officers should be stationed. Evaluation forms will again be handed out at the end of the walk, and students will fill in their grade. Volunteers are needed for this event. Adult escorts are needed at 6:30pm on October 23. Help is needed with decorating on October 22 3:00pm-6:00pm. Youth Committee has a meeting today. Colleen will look into getting volunteers from the Middle School, and she will also provide transportation from Middle School to High School on October 13 or October 14. Call Youth Committee members for details or talk to Marcie. Marcie reported the students have raised \$600. Amy will sell bottled water and pass out candy to those who fill out evaluation forms. Emily suggested making a sticker to put HCHY information on the water.

Badge Sales: Heritage day brought in \$135, and the football games have made \$50-\$75 each for the spirit badge sales. Help from Youth Committee will be needed with badge sales on October 15 for the Copley vs Cloverleaf football game. We need adult members to sell the "Beat Revere" badges on October 22. Discussion to expand badge sales to include different football game sayings. Marcie reported we have access to a button-making machine.

Discussion that students age 13 or 7th grade and up can be members of HCHY Youth Committee.

Copley Township trustees approved buying 48 t-shirts for the youth committee, \$500.00.
